DAY 10: INTERNATIONALITY AND MISSION

We began the day with the Eucharistic celebration English sung by our Indian sisters in vernacular languages. We then gathered in the assembly to share our reflections, questions on internationality. Sr. Catherine Barange read the approved text on the international community and the proposals from the P/R/S from the 2017 General Chapter. Then, Rita Bujold presented the international community's report prepared by all the sisters who served during this mandate: Sisters Vimala ALEXANDER, Rita BUJOLD, Mary PALLATHUKUDY, Josette GUIRAUD, Siham SAMI and Syria SUSAIMUTHU.

Following a prayer inspired by our Constitutions and guided by the Chapter animator: Our gathering as Congregation calls us to live profound unity among ourselves » (supplement 6/12), we divided in two large groups (3 teams in each group to reflect on these themes:

- ✚ Internationality of the Congregation
- ✚ The international community

Then, through the synthesis by the groups' secretaries, we were able to live a time of sincere sharing and a deep desire to deepen this theme.

We also moved on to another lively theme, "the Mission." We read the proposals of the Provinces, Regions and Sectors. We were sent for a time of personal prayer asking for the grace of discernment to welcome with courage and creativity the mission to which we are called in our apostolic service.

The day ended with our spiritual conversation in small groups waiting to share this in the following day's assembly.
